There is no need to locate, contact and obtain permission directly from each of our affiliates. The SESAC license has been designed to be easy to complete and understand.

Why do I need a SESAC license? A copyrighted song is someone's property and under the Copyright Law of the United States you must get permission from the owner before using his or her property. SESAC represents thousands of songwriters and is authorized by them to issue licenses that provide the necessary authorization for you to be in compliance with the law.

Tell me more about the SESAC license. A SESAC license is the least complicated and most economical way to obtain access and the required permission to publicly perform the copyrighted music in the vast SESAC repertory. The SESAC blanket license grants you unlimited access to perform all of the copyrighted music in the SESAC repertory as often as you like.

How do I know if I am playing SESAC music? SESAC has experienced tremendous growth over the decades and currently represents a significant amount of music written and performed in the United States in all musical genres. Our diverse repertory includes Folk music, Big Band, Jazz, New Age, Easy Listening, Adult Contemporary, Urban, R&B, Top 40, Pop, Hip Hop, Rock, Rap, Blues, Country, Bluegrass, Gospel, Contemporary Christian, Latin/Hispanic, Tejano, Salsa, Caribbean, Polka, Band, Choral, Classical, Educational, and Children's music, as well as, Radio, Cable, TV and Internet jingles. This status subjects the unlicensed music user to damages ranging up to \$150,000 for each song performed without proper authorization. Additionally, the court may allow the recovery of full costs including attorney's fees.

It is a better business decision to secure the low-cost SESAC license and be assured that you are covered to play any of the songs in the SESAC repertory in your establishment. We encourage you to speak with your attorney or contact SESAC if you have additional questions.
